On 1/21/2011, at approximately 2:50 pm, I was dispatched to the area of 150 North St for a possible MVA involving a City of Middletown police vehicle. Upon arrival, I was advised by Officer Berman, that as he was conducting a traffic stop, the mirror to vehicle 13 was struck by another vehicle () which was traveling south on North St. Officer Berman further stated that his emergency lights were activated at the time his vehicle was struck. At the time of my arrival, vehicle 13 was facing south on North St and was parked appropriately in accordance with a vehicle stop. I inspected both vehicles and neither had any damage, as the mirrors flexed according to design. Photographs were taken of both vehicles and will be placed into IMPACT for future reference.
